Access

We recognise that providing equal access is an ongoing process and we welcome comments and suggestions from our performers and patrons.

Please contact the box office if you require space for a wheelchair, we will be happy to help.

Wheelchair spaces are situated on Row A and are only available in advance. One unisex wheelchair accessible WC is situated at ground level to the left of the foyer.

Unfortunately the bar is not wheelchair accessible, but a member of staff will gladly bring your refreshments to your seat.

Patrons with restricted mobility can easily be accommodated on Row A.

Refreshments

Our lounge bar is located on the first floor, and our kiosk sells light refreshments on the ground floor. Both are open on show days before the show and during the interval.

You are welcome to take your drink into the auditorium, just ask our friendly bar staff who will provide you with a plastic glass. To avoid disappointment during the interval, don't forget to place your interval drinks order at the order point located in the foyer prior to the show.

Please do not bring your own food and drinks into the theatre at any time.

Interval and Timing

Intervals vary with each event and on some occasions there are none at all.

Please note latecomers will not be admitted until a suitable break in the performance.

Photographic Equipment

Cameras and audio and video equipment are not allowed during any performance.

How To Find Us

Gracie Fields Theatre is adjacent to Oulder Hill Leisure Complex, Hudsons Walk, Rochdale, OL11 5EF.

By Car

The Gracie Fields Theatre is approximately 2 miles from the M62. Leave the M62 at junction 20 then at the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A627 (M) sign posted Rochdale. Following signs for Rochdale turn left onto the A664. At the traffic lights get into the Blackburn lane and continue forward onto Sandy Lane. Turn left onto Hudsons Walk sign posted Gracie Fields Theatre.

Please note when using SatNav we recommend you use the postcode OL11 5EW as this will take you the most direct route to the theatre.

Parking

There is ample space in our floodlit car park.

By Rail

Rochdale Train Station is 2.35 miles from the Gracie Fields Theatre. A taxi journey from the train station to the theatre should cost no more than £5.00 each way.

Rochdale is regularly serviced with trains from Manchester Victoria and Leeds. For timetable details please visit www.nationalrail.co.uk or call National Rail Enquiries on 08457 48 49 50.

By Bus

Service Numbers 436 and 468 from Rochdale Bus Station stop at Greave Avenue which is approximately 5 minutes walk from the theatre.

A taxi journey from Rochdale Bus Station/Town Centre should cost no more than £5.00 each way.

Service number 469 operates From Bury Road/Sandy Lane (outside Cemetery Hotel) to Rochdale Bus Station until approximately 11.30pm most evenings.

- Leave the theatre through the Car Park walking down Hudsons walk.
- After 35 yds turn right onto Sandy lane
- After 30 yds turn left onto Bury Road B6452
- The closest bus stop is outside the Cemetery Hotel.
